

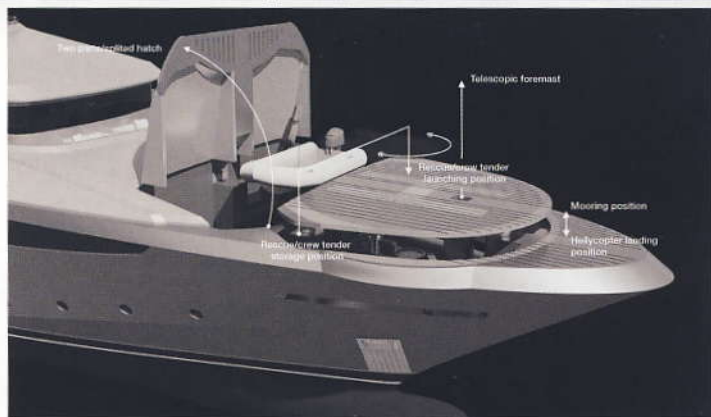


NEW SORAYA 46

Gentech Yachts set to launch 152-footer in 2010

LAUNCHING IN AUGUST 2010 from Gentech Yachts in Liechtenstein is the Soraya 46, a 152-foot yacht destined for high-end charter and private use. Designed and built in compliance with RINA and MCA standards, the Soraya 46 can accommodate 12 passengers in six staterooms and nine crew, whose access to the guest areas is designed to enhance guest privacy and enjoyment, while ensuring the vessel's safety and the efficient performance of the crew's duties. The yacht's interior layout, which can be modified to each owner's needs, was created by Jure Bukavec of UNIPELLÉ yacht design.

Naval architecture was provided by Italy-based Meccano Engineering. Highlights of the Soraya 46 include a helipad, which is designed to rise and give access to a forward-mooring



locker, and a swim platform that unfolds and doubles in size, offering an enormous area for guests and toys.

Built at Gentech's Antalya, Turkey, facility, the first Soraya 46 is scheduled for delivery in August 2010 and will be available for viewing at the 2010 Monaco Yacht Show.
