

VISTA

reated by Uniellé Yacht Design, Vista is a modern 85m displacement motoryacht. The steel and aluminium structure offers accommodation for 12 guests and features an interior created in collaboration with Ales Bratina. Director of Uniellé Jure Bukavec highlights some of the features of the concept.

In the development of this concept, we wanted to open the interior to the surrounding environment as much as possible. We've included forward-thinking ideas that go further than simply including a plumb bow, which we purposely avoided on this design. Instead, we focused on creating synergy between the sharp and soft aspects of the design and combining these with the complex concave to convex shapes of the exterior, which ensure Vista looks different from any angle.

It was important that the design should allow guests to enjoy all areas of the yacht, regardless of whether they are in the interior or exterior. By opening up the exterior, guests can get better views out to sea, while also letting natural light into the inside of the vessel. We have included a large infinity pool



on the aft main deck, while a touch-and-go helipad at the bow makes it easy and quick to reach and depart from the vessel. The lower deck includes a beach club, as three sides of the hull fold out to create a walk around space. This deck includes a spa, which is flooded with natural light from the glass-bottom pool above it. Glass has also been incorporated into the floor of the upper aft deck to allow more light onto the deck below.

The split-deck interior offers two salons amidships with floor-to-ceiling windows and balconies. The owner's deck includes a private terrace, as does the VIP en suite. A central elevator extends from the lower deck to the sundeck, where we have included a bar and Jacuzzi area.

Keeping under 3,000gt and with a 14m beam, Vista offers all the comforts you would expect of a 100m vessel. However, being 15m shorter provides her owner with the option of visiting many more ports and bays than would otherwise be possible.
